ABOUT THE ARTIST

Noam Pikelny has emerged as the preeminent banjoist of his generation. Hailed by the *Chicago Tribune* as the "pros' top banjo picker," Pikelny is a founding member of Punch Brothers, a string ensemble which the *Boston Globe* calls "a virtuosic revelation" and the *New Yorker* describes as "wide-ranging and restlessly imaginative." In September 2010, Pikelny was awarded the first annual Steve Martin Prize for Excellence in Banjo and Bluegrass. Pikelny is a three-time Grammy® Award nominee and his record, *Noam Pikelny Plays Kenny Baker Plays Bill Monroe*, was described by the *New York Times* as "a token of reverence, a feat of translation and a show of dominion". The album is widely considered a landmark recording in acoustic music, and was named Album of the Year at the 2014 International Bluegrass Music Association Awards. Pikelny will release his next album, the purely solo endeavor. *Universal Favorite*. on Rounder Records in March 2017.
